The registration fees, all offerings received during all our preaching services and other fund raising projects will go toward covering all the costs of our reunion. The anticipated costs for the reunion will be about \$21,000 and it is expected that the registration/housing/meal fees will raise \$14,000 and the balance of \$7000 from donations and fundraisers.

Since 2 reunions are being combined this year, the first floor of Lodge will be reserved only after the registrar receives a \$50 deposit. Please consider sharing a room, so there will be beds for all who need the first floor. Deposits and housing requests will not be considered until after January.

It is planned to have Fund Raising events to help with the cost of Reunion. The **Penny Jar** race is on! Many congregations have all ready started filling their jars. As we did in previous years, congregations will fill a jar with Money and bring it to Reunion to see which congregation collected the most. There are trophies to be awarded to that congregation! Last year \$2091.44 was collected for Reunion expenses. Richmond has won the first place trophy for many years. Who will raise the most this year???
